Current Public Facility Projects

The City uses the CDBG program to fund activities which will improve public facilities which are primarily used by low income people and to make infrastructure improvements in areas of the community which are primarily low income.

CDBG funds are provided to local non-profit agencies and other City departments to promote handicap accessibility in public buildings and parks.

Public Facility Improvement and Handicap Accessibility activities funded in 2014/2015 include the following:

GREAT FALLS CITY PARK & RECREATION - COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER Purchase and replacement of existing doors with ADA energy efficient entryway doors for the Community Recreation Center located at 801 2nd Avenue North	\$32,000
GREAT FALLS CITY PARK & RECREATION - MORONY NATATORIUM Asbestos sampling, testing, removal of flooring, installation of floor tiles in lobby, bathrooms and hallways located at 111 12th Street North	\$13,000
GREAT FALLS CITY PARK & RECREATION - DUDLEY ANDERSON PARK Purchase and install handicap accessible play structure and play area border at Dudley Anderson Park located at 701 334d Street South	\$30,000
GREAT FALLS CITY PUBLIC WORKS - 3RD AVENUE NORTH Reconstruct 3rd Avenue North from 10th Street to 12th Street, including replacement of asphalt, curb and gutter, domes and sidewalks and installing handicap ramps	\$130,328
GREAT FALLS CITY PUBLIC WORKS - SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT Grant program to provide assistance to low income homeowners to remove and replace hazardous sidewalks in portions of Census Tract 4 and 5 (boundaries of 8th Avenue North to 2nd Avenue South and Park Drive to 15th Street) and other areas at request of low income homeowners	\$30,000
OPPORTUNITIES, INC. Repair of roof for the Youth Employment Center located at 622 1st Avenue South	\$20,672
CENTER FOR MENTAL HEALTH Replacement of existing windows and doors with energy efficient windows and ADA compliant door located at 513 1st Avenue South	\$10,500
PARIS GIBSON SQUARE MUSEUM - ADA ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT Replacement of existing west doors to improve ADA access and energy efficiency located at 1400 1st	\$10,000
