Participation is simple. For every book read through August 14 participants will be able to submit an entry for a grand prize drawing, which will be held on Wednesday, August 15 at the Summer Reading final party. Entry forms will be available at the library. Prizes include a year's worth of free downtown parking, a Sony e-reader, and a \$50 gift certificate from Big Mouth Barbeque.

We will also hold drawings every two weeks for participants who submit correctly completely games and quizzes. Prizes will include extra-large book bags, t-shirts, and coffee mugs.
