Presidential and Montana Governor Half-Staff Notifications

Goveror Bullock hereby orders all flags flown in the State of Montana to be flown at half staff on Tuesday, December 16th, 2014 to honor the memory of Former First Lady Carol Judge who died on December 7th, 2014 in Helena, Montana.

Display of U.S. Flag

The United States Code identifies several days when a particular effort should be made to display the U.S. Flag. Those days are:

- New Year's Day, January 1
- Inauguration Day, January 20
- Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday, third Monday in January
- Lincoln's Birthday, February 12
- Washington's Birthday, third Monday in February
- Easter Sunday (variable)
- Mother's Day, second Sunday in May
- Peace Officers Memorial Day, May 15 (half-staff sunrise until sunset)
- Armed Forces Day, third Saturday in May
- Memorial Day (half-staff until noon), the last Monday in May
- Flag Day, June 14
- Independence Day, July 4
- Labor Day, first Monday in September
- Patriot Day, September 11 (half-staff sunrise until sunset)
- Constitution Day, September 17

- Veterans Day, November 11
- Thanksgiving Day, fourth Thursday in November
- Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, December 7 (half-staff sunrise to sunset)
