**PROJECT TITLE:** Bank Stabilization Project at West Bank Park, (O.F. 1336)

**RECOMMENDED CONTRACTOR:** Sierra Rock & Dirt Inc.

**CONTRACT AMOUNT:** \$20,250.00

**ENGINEERS ESTIMATE:** \$26,600.00

**BUDGETED FUND:** Water Treatment Plant Capital Improvement

**START DATE:** October, 2002 (Projected)

**COMPLETION DATE:** November, 2002 (30 Calendar Days)

**PENALTY/INCENTIVE TERMS:** Liquidated Damages, \$800.00/Day

**SYNOPSIS:**

The Bank Stabilization Project at West Bank Park, (O.F. 1336) is a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) created to stabilize the streambank along the Missouri River. The City of Great Falls was required to perform the SEP as a result of a settlement agreement with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). EPA conducted an audit to the City's pretreatment program in early 2000. On December 27, 2000, EPA issued a Complaint and Compliance Order alleging pretreatment violations. The Complaint proposed a civil penalty of \$8,500. In addition, the City agreed to perform a SEP for not less than \$33,375 (engineering and construction).

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**CONTRACT BID AWARD: O.F. 1336**

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**BACKGROUND:**

The SEP is a pollution reduction project to stabilize and protect approximately 300 feet of eroding streambank on the Missouri River. The project will utilize bank sloping, matting, and re-vegetation. Stabilization will reduce siltation, suspended solids, and turbidity, which cause impaired fish habitat in the river. The work also will prevent contaminant migration to the river. The project is located at the south end of West Bank Park, immediately north of the 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue North Bridge.

Bids were opened on October 2, 2002, with three contractors submitting bids. Sierra Rock & Dirt, Inc. submitted a bid of \$20,250. The engineer's estimate for the project was \$26,600.

Delta Engineering P.C. completed the project design and will provide field inspection. City Engineering Staff assisted with contract administration and will assist with inspection duties.
