RECOMMENDATION:

Following the public hearing and barring sufficient protest, staff recommends adoption of Resolution 9407.

MOTION:

“I move to adopt Resolution 9407.”

SYNOPSIS:

On July 6, 2004 the City Commission set an August 3, 2004 public hearing date to hear anyone wishing to speak for or against the Boulevard Maintenance Assessment.

The General Boulevard Area assessment for fiscal year 04/05 will be \$289,725.00, the same amount assessed in FY 03/04. This will result in an assessment of \$61.71 for an average lot of 7,500 square feet.

BACKGROUND:

In order to legally provide for the necessary assessment support, State laws require City Commission hearings and passage of authorizing resolutions. Sections 7-12-4401 and 7-12-4428, M.C.A., authorize the City Commission to create and assess the costs of work, improvements, and maintenance to the owners of property within the boundaries of such districts.
