**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Commission reappoint Judith Sargent, and appoint one new member to the Civic Center Advisory Board for three-year terms through December 31, 2007.

**MOTION:** I move the City Commission reappoint Judith Sargent, and appoint \_\_\_\_\_ for three-year terms through December 31, 2007.

**SYNOPSIS:** Ms. Sargent was appointed to fill the remainder of a three-year term on the Civic Center Advisory Board on March 20, 2001. She was reappointed on December 4, 2001, for a three-year term which expires December 31, 2004. She is eligible for and interested in reappointment. Mr. Kuiper was appointed August 15, 2000, to fill the remainder of a three-year term. He was reappointed on December 4, 2001, for a three-year term which expires December 31, 2004. Mr. Kuiper is not interested in reappointment; therefore, it is necessary to appoint a new member.

**BACKGROUND:** The Civic Center Advisory Board was created in 1997. The Board acts in an advisory capacity to the City Commission and the City Manager on all matters related to the successful operation of the Civic Center facilities. The Board consists of five to seven members with an attempt to have representation from the areas of performing arts, conventions and meetings, and civic leaders.
