RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the City Commission accept Ordinance No. 2897 on the first reading and set the final reading for January 18, 2005.

MOTION:

I move the City Commission accept Ordinance No. 2897 on first reading and set the final reading for January 18, 2005.

SYNOPSIS:

Ordinance No. 2897 will add the following verbiage to OCCGF 3.04.070 Sell, trade or lease – Personal Property, item B “Or the City may place the item for sale on an internet auction site with an established minimum price”.

BACKGROUND:

Currently the City may sell, trade or lease any personal property by negotiation without advertising for bids, for any period of time, unless the value of the property exceeds \$10,000, whereupon such sale must be made to the highest bidder.

The change in verbiage would allow the City to advertise items on line to obtain the maximum value for personal property.
